Basic Terms & Conditions

1. **Students of VSICS/ VSIPS/ DAMS will participate.**
2. **Students of MBA/MCA/ BCA/BBA are eligible.**
3. **One student can only participate in maximum two events. If anyone is participating in two events it must be ensured that it is one Cultural activity and another Literal activity.**
4. **One faculty is desirable per 15 students from each course for coordination of the activities. Heads of the departments may appoint more faculty members.**
5. **If any participant is not present at the time of event, walkover will be given to others.**
6. **Decisions by the appointed panel of rational judges will be final (only for activities to be held on Day 1). It is expected that the students will honor the decision of the judges.**
7. **Students must carry their college Identity Card with entry pass. They are supposed to produce it whenever demanded.**
8. **Registrations will get closed by Dec 20, 2023.**
9. **For all the music-based participation, the music/ song must be revealed 1 week before the date of the event. Students have to prepare LED screen video related with event. It is important for coordination of the event.**

SRIJAN is a two day event.

10. **On Day 1, the participants must report latest by 8:30 a.m. sharp for literal events at VSICS Campus.**
11. **On Day 2, the participants must report by 02:00 pm sharp.**
12. **Results of all the competitions and Prize Distribution Ceremony will be done later, schedule for the same will be informed later.**

Rules / Guidelines for specific events

DAY 1

Event 1 - General Quiz

1. Team Size: **2 members from each team.**
2. Quiz will be based on General Awareness only.

Event 2 - Ad Mad Show

1. The activity consists of two rounds. In first round one product will be given to the team. The team will be asked to **pack the product** as per legal & commercial norms. Basic raw material which is required for packaging should be brought by the participants.
2. Teams will be asked for creation and endorsement for promotion of Brand through advertisement. The composite marks earned in packing and advertisement will be the base of winning the event.
3. Team Size: **4 members from each team.**
4. Time Duration 30 min for first round and in second round for advertisement 2 min will be given. In case of taking excess time negative marking will be done.
5. **Props are not allowed.**

Event 3 - Ad Lib: Extempore

1. Team Size: **1 member from each team.**
2. Spot topic will be given to all randomly.
3. Time limit: 2 min for each candidate for expressing your idea.

5. 30 seconds for Idea formation after you read the topic.
6. Basis of marking will be communication skills, confidence, reasoning and logical speech.

Event 4 - Kaavyanjali

1. Team Size: **1 member from each team.**
2. Theme: Prakartik Saundarya (Nature's Beauty)
3. Max Time limit: 3 min for each candidate.

Event 5 - Abhivyakti

1. Teams have to prepare a video film picturized on team members only. Nature's voice as the background is only acceptable. Story will be narrated by one narrator belonging to one of the team member only on the stage.

2. Theme: – “**Narration of Ramayana Episode**”.
3. Movie will be of 5 min. at the maximum. The message should be clearly expressed.
4. **Maximum 6 members** can participate.
5. **Episode will be allotted via Organizing Secretary**

Event 6 - TAP: Thematic Aptitude Test

1. Team Size: **2 members from each team.**
2. Power point slide will be shown based on which an idea has to be narrated.
3. Logical & positive thinking, communication skills, confidence and coordination between the team members will be criteria of evaluation.
4. After showing the slide, 2 min. will be given for idea formation.
5. Two minutes for expressing your idea.

Event 7 - Logo Designing

1. **Team Size: 2 members** from each team.
2. Teams will be assigned the name of any existing company. They have to design its new logo. It must be new, developed by the creativity of members and teams will be explaining the promotional significance of logo designed by them.
3. Logo will be designed and presented through electronic gadget.
4. **Total time 0100 hrs for designing and max. 5 mins for presenting.**
5. Only Coral Draw (version 14) or Adobe Photoshop (version 7) software will be used.

Event 8 - Antakshari

1. **Team Size: 2 members** from each team.
2. **All the rules of the competition will be disclosed at the time of event itself.**
3. Antakshari will be based on Bollywood songs and Private musical albums.

Event 9 - Poster Making

1. **Team Size: 1 member** from each team.
2. Theme: **Reviving traditions in current scenario.**
3. Max. time 2 Hrs.
4. Poster to be designed and presented through chart paper.

Event 10 - Cartooning

1. **Team Size: 1 member** from each team.
2. Theme will be provided on the spot.

3. Candidate has to arrange for **A4 sheet and pencil**.
4. Use of Black Pencil only
5. Candidate is free to make anything of his choice. Time limit **two hours**.

Event 11 - Insta Poster

1. **Team Size: 2 member** from each team.
2. Theme: Punch Line Presentation
3. Use of **coral draw (version 14) or Adobe photoshop (version 7)**
4. **Aspect Ratio – 1:1**
5. **Time – 90 Mins**
6. **Topic will be provided on the spot.**

Event 12 - Rangoli

1. **Team Size: 1 member** from each team.
2. Theme: ‘**Optical Illusion**’
3. Rangoli will be made on 2x2 foot ceramic tile only.
4. Use of oil paints only, nothing for decoration.
5. Total time for Rangoli designing will be **0200 hrs**.

Event 13 - Spell Bee

1) **Team size : 1 member from each team**

2) **Round 1 – Preliminary Round**

- Participants will be given a set of 5 words each to spell correctly
- Participant with most number of correctly spelt words will move to the next round.
- Spell the words loud and clear.
- The round continues until only a certain number of participants remain or until all the words are spelled.

Round 2 – Vocabulary Round

- Participants are presented with sentences containing challenging words.
- The word must be spelled correctly after hearing the sentence.
- Incorrect spelling will lead to termination from the round immediately.

Round 3 – Championship Round

- The remaining participants compete head-to-head.

- Spell the words.
 - Single mistake leads to elimination.
 - The winner, runner will be according to the number of correctly spelled words.
- 3) The speller will be counted on the words correctly spelled.
 - 4) Spellers cannot pass or skip words.
 - 5) Spellers who spelled the greatest number of words correctly during their turn will be declared the winner.
 - 6) The spellings should be according to the dictionary.
 - 7) The speller can ask the meaning of the word and to repeat the word to be spelt.
 - 8) Decision of the judges will be final.

Event 14 - Coding Mandapam

- **Level 1: Simple**
 - Format: Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ)
 - Questions: 20 MCQ-based questions
 - Time Limit: 20 minutes
 - Syllabus: Basic concept of Programming
- **Level 2: Moderate**
 - Format: Program Writing
 - Questions: 5 program-writing questions
 - Selection: Participants can choose and solve any 3 out of 5 questions
 - Time Limit: 20 minutes
 - Syllabus: Coordinational Looping based Logic
- **Level 3: Complex**
 - Format: C programming code-related tasks (output finding or code rearrangement)
 - Questions: 3 code-related tasks
 - Selection: Participants can choose and solve any 2 out of 3 questions
 - Time Limit: 30 minutes
 - Syllabus: Loops, Array and String handling in C language.

General Rules:

- After 1st and 2nd round, one team with lowest score will be eliminated
- **Maximum 2 students of each team can participate.**
- Participants are expected to maintain the highest standards of integrity and fair play. Cheating or plagiarism will not be tolerated and may result in disqualification.

- Strictly adhere to the time limits specified for each level. Failure to do so may result in point deductions or disqualification.
- Scoring will be based on correct answers and the quality of the solutions provided
- For all programming tasks only C programming language will be used

DAY 2

Event 1 - Fashion Show

1. **Team Size: 8 members** from each team.
2. Theme: **'Glitz & Glam'**
3. **Time 5 min.** for each team.
4. Props are allowed.
5. No assisting member is allowed on stage except 8 team members.

Event 2 - Rhythm: Solo Singing

1. **Team Size: 1 member** from each team.
2. Theme: **'Free Style'**
3. **Time limit 4 minutes** (Max).
4. Students must take care that song is **not an indecent one** otherwise they may be disqualified.
5. Medley up to 3 songs permitted.

Event 3 - Dance Pe Chance: Solo Dance

1. **Team Size: 1 member** from each team.
2. Theme: **Hip-hop.**
3. Medley up to 3 songs.
4. Total time per student 3-5 min.

Event 4 - Duet Song

1. **Team Size: 2 members** from each team.
2. Theme: **'Free Style'**
3. Medley up to 4 songs permitted.
4. Total time team 3-5 min.

Event 5 - TAAL: Group Dance

1. **Team Size: 6 members** from each team.
2. Theme: **'Carnival'**, Medley up to 3 songs.

3. Time per team 3-5 min.
